AIR BP – ALICE SPRINGS AIRPORT Refuelling Facility Upgrade

Description of Project:

In April, 2011 Northern Refueling Maintenance was awarded the contract for the upgrade of the general aviation refuelling facility at the Alice Springs Airport, Northern Territory.

Major works included in NRM's scope were:

- Sheet piling the delicate excavation site in preparation for underground tank removal and installation.
- Removal and disposal of the exiting underground tank and appurtenances.
- Installation of 1 x 110KL double contained underground fibreglass Avgas Tank.
- Relocation and upgrade of the existing Avgas Card Swipe Skid and shelter.
- Supply and installation of a dewatering vessel.
- Supply and installation of the interconnecting pipe work between the tank, Card Swipe and the new pump/filtration skid.
- Provision and installation of the electrical interfaces including the new switchboard.
- Commissioning of complete installation.

This project in Alice Springs was NRM's first venture into this part of Central Australia. The successful delivery of this project extended the reach and confirmed NRM's ability to deliver challenging projects in remote areas of Australia.

Northern Refueling Maintenance thrives on the challenges presented by remote area work sites.
