Description of Project:

Following successful implementation of the hydrant line extension works at Cairns Airport, Northern Refueling Maintenance were invited to tender for the mechanical works associated with the western hydrant line extension of the JAFS (Joint Aviation Fuelling System) for Darwin International Airport. Major works included in NRM's scope were:

- Installation of approximately 150 meters of 200NB pipe.
- Installation of new valves.
- Construction and installation of new valve pit.
- Flushing and hydrostatic testing of new extension.
